The Office of Student Engagement and the Greek Week Committee reserves the right to reapprove or alter this packet if deemed necessary.

General Guidelines:

1. All participants must be active or new members of a recognized chapter at Tennessee Tech University. Participants must be listed on the chapter roster to participate in any event. Participants must be in good standing at the university and their chapter.
2. Cancellation or postponement of an event due to weather or other circumstances is at the discretion of the Office of Student Engagement. Notice of cancellations or postponements will be made directly to each chapter's president via email, GroupMe, and social media.
3. Points will be determined based on the Greek Week events' participation and placements in events.
4. The chosen judges for the cheer competition will be the primary judges. If you have questions about a rule or need further interpretation of a rule for the judging process, please ask and contact us via the greeklife@tntech.edu email.
5. Any inappropriate behavior against the Fraternity and Sorority Life spirit at TTU, as viewed by the Office of Student Engagement, may result in a loss of points, disqualification from the named event, or removal from participation in Greek Week as a whole.
6. All fraternity and sorority members participating in Greek Week 2025 shall understand that all activities relating to Greek Week are not to involve the possession or consumption of alcohol, tobacco, or illegal substances.

Greek Week Overview:

- All events will be completed in teams determined by the Greek Week Ie. Size, council, and participation will be considered when making teams to be as fair as possible.
- This year, we are doing NFL for the overall theme! Each team will get to choose which NFL team they would like to represent. For example, one team may be the Titans, and base their events around this team for the week!

Event Breakdown:

Wristbands

Each wristband will cost \$7 per person, and allow entry to each event

Wristbands will be sold in the Fraternity and Sorority Office, starting Monday at 8 AM

- Purchase of a wristband does not guarantee attendance points for events
- Wristbands only allow entry of event

Raising Canes Spirit Night

- **Time:** 4 pm - 10 pm
- **Location:** 1100 Interstate Dr, Cookeville, TN 38501

Points will be rewarded based on the amount of dollars spent at Canes. For every dollar = 1 point. The cut off will be \$20/20 points/receipt.

- Your receipts will be turned in on Wednesday 04/09 at the penny drop location in your designated team's bucket.
- If your receipt is not turned into the penny drop, it will not be counted

Flag Football Tournament

- **Time:** 5pm - 8 pm
- **Location:** The Intramural Fields
- **Cost Per Extra Team:** \$10
- **Cost of Entry:** \$5

Rules will be announced by the referees prior to the event

There will be a men's division and a women's division for participation

Attendance will be collected at the door, and will be totaled as participation points, as seen in the point breakdown

- All participants must sign a liability waiver prior to playing
- Each team may provide a maximum of 2 Men's teams, and 2 Women's teams
 - 1 Men's Team and 1 Women's Team will be allowed to play free. Additional teams will cost \$10 per team
 - Each team consisting of a maximum of 10 players
 - Teams must contain members of multiple organizations to qualify for participation
 - All players have free entry into the event

- Liability waivers will be provided by the Office of Student Engagement at the event
- This will be a Single Elimination Bracket

Penny Drop

- **Time:** 10am - 2 pm
- **Location:** RUC

Each team will have a bucket set up on the table. Teams can add coins to their bucket or cash to other team's buckets.

- Coins = Positive points
- Dollar Bills = Negative Points
- Points will be rewarded based on 1st, 2nd, and 3rd placement (as seen in point breakdown)
- No Venmo or checks!
- Receipts for the Cane's Spirit night must be turned in to the team's bucket, but will not count toward the overall penny drop total

Cheer Competition

- **Times:** 5pm- 7pm
- **Location:** Memorial Gym
- **Cost of Team:** \$10
- **Cost of Entry:** \$5

Scoring of the cheer competition will be based on creativity, theme Inclusion, and execution

Attendance will be collected at the door, and will be totaled as participation points, as seen in the point breakdown

- The cheer competition will include teams of 25 members maximum, at least one participant from each chapter
 - Minimum of 10 participants per team
- Each performance can be a maximum of 5 minutes
- The routine must be “Greek positive” meaning no slander or negative verbiage toward other teams
- Any unassisted stunts or flips will result in point deduction or disqualification

A list of participants must be turned in by Friday, March 14, 2025

Music must be turned in by Friday, March 21, 2025

Video of routine must be turned in by Friday, April 4, 2025

Tailgate W/ Wall Build

- **Times:** 11 am - 3pm
 - Set up begins at 10 am
- **Location:** Football Field Parking Lot
- **Cost of Entry:** \$5

Habitat for Humanity will bring all supplies needed to host a "Wall Build" in the middle of the tailgate. This will allow each team to contribute in building a Habitat for Humanity House! While partaking in the "Wall Build" each team may set up their own tailgate event with tents or games for their team members to participate in!

- Teams are allowed to provide their own food through a "pot luck" style, or grilling out at their tents
- Attendance will be collected at this event, and points will be given based on team's attendance, as seen in the point breakdown
 - Attendance will stop at 1:30, and any entry after will not count for points
- No points or prizes will be awarded for tailgate set up or games
- No alcohol related games are allowed
 - Ex: Beer Pong (cup pong), Beer Die (cup die), etc
- Winners of the overall Greek Week will be announced at the end of this event

T-shirts:

A link to the T-shirt sale will be sent out via email and GroupMe to presidents or designated contact. The link will be open from Monday 8 AM - Friday 4 PM

- For every t- shirt bought by team they will receive 20 points

Monetary Fundraising:

A fundraising link will be sent out to each team via email, GroupMe, and social media. Monetary value may be donated through this link. When donating, it must be specified which team the value is for, to count toward point total

- Points will be dispersed on 1st, 2nd, and 3rd based on the monetary value raised.
- The link will be open from Monday at 8:00 am to Wednesday at 4 pm
